Six of the company's material recovery facilities (MRFs), providing recycling services to industrial, commercial and residential customers, are based in Wisconsin.

2023 BUSINESS FRIEND OF THE ENVIRONMENT

WM safely and sustainably manages waste by implementing processes and technologies to reduce environmental impact, including mitigating emissions and repurposing landfill gas. Eight of the company's nine landfills in Wisconsin are gas-to-energy facilities, at which gas is processed into high-purity methane that can be used as a source for renewable electricity or renewable fuel.

Last year, WM made its largest investment in compressed natural gas (CNG) trucks and fueling infrastructure to transform its Wisconsin fleet. WM transitioned 43 of its trucks from diesel to renewable natural gas (RNG)-powered vehicles — more than doubling the number of CNG trucks serving communities across the state and significantly reducing GHG, NOx and CO2e emissions.

Additionally, to support its updated fleet, WM unveiled a hauling site in Germantown outfitted with a renewable natural gas fueling system.

For leveraging its infrastructure and expertise to ensure sustainability, WM is receiving this Business Friend of the Environment Award.



The Pellitteri family provides trash pickup, recycling, temporary dumpsters, compactor systems and confidential paper shredding services to residential and commercial customers throughout Southern Wisconsin.

2023 BUSINESS FRIEND OF THE ENVIRONMENT

One of Pellitteri's core values is environmental stewardship. At the company's state-of-the-art Material Recovery Facility (MRF), the team diverts materials from the landfill and recovers them for recycling and reuse.

Pellitteri recently identified a growing problem of "wishcycling," or non-recyclable materials being sent to the recycling center. The company embarked on a two-pronged approach of using education to decrease the amount of non-recyclable items coming into the MRF while also adding robotics, Al and optical sorting equipment to further increase the recyclables accepted.

By using educational and technological advancements simultaneously, the team ensures a continual growth model. The company offers free tours of their facility and public access to educational materials through their website and video series to increase knowledge on proper recycling.

Since 2020, the non-recyclable materials (residual) coming out of its MRF fell by a full 24% year over year in 2021 and again fell by another 8% in 2022. This equates to a reduction of 10,283,000 pounds of trash coming through the facility.

For combining education and technological advancements to improve recycling, Pellitteri Waste Systems is receiving the Business Friend of the Environment Award.





ABOUT EXACT SCIENCES

Headquartered in Madison, Exact Sciences develops tests for the early detection and treatment of cancers. Their mission is to eradicate cancer and the suffering it causes — through tests that help prevent it, detection that finds it earlier and guidance for its successful treatment.

2023 BUSINESS FRIEND OF THE ENVIRONMENT

In their development of new cancer screening tests, Exact Sciences makes it a priority to properly dispose of the plastics used in their clinical lab.

The company recently found ways to improve energy efficiency and odor control while reducing water consumption, the amount of waste sent to landfill, and the risk of safety incidents associated with manual lifting of waste.

A new clinical lab waste processing system is used to recycle the plastics involved in its Cologuard sample collection and testing processes so they can be re-used to create new products. This new system also reduces energy use, electricity consumption, gas consumption and total water use.

Exact Sciences recycles over 94% of the plastic waste associated with its Cologuard sample collection kits, equating to more than 2.5 million pounds of plastic waste diverted from landfill in 2022. The plastic waste is converted to plastic pellets for use in new applications.

For their development of their clinical lab waste processing system, Exact Sciences is receiving this Business Friend of the Environment Award.
